CARR QUEEN vied for the lead off the rail to midstretch, responded when roused and then edged clear in a hand ride. IRREPRESSIBLE JOY vied for the lead along the three path, battled in the lane, was no match late but finished second best. CAM A RETTA lagged back along the three path, angled out some in the lane and finished well. P J'S KID lagged back while five wide on the turn, continued wide in the lane and made a mild bid. KIMRY MOOR was well placed while five wide leaving the backstretch, tracked the leaders along the four path on the turn and weakened. EENI MEENI IBIS forced the issue early along the rail and tired. PRINCESS HEIDI broke sluggishly and then was six wide on the turn. KATHRYN THE GRANNY was well placed while five wide on the turn and tired. SECRET SOUNDS reared badly in the gate at the start and unseated the jockey. A stewards inquiry was posted concerning the start, resulted in no change.
