Footnotes

OLTON ALLEY mid pack and inside, angled out and looped up three wide through the second turn, came four wide to bid, then made a steady gain and edged ahead in the final strides. TORREY PARK stalked the early pace on the outside, bid outside of that one into the stretch, then angled in and gained a short lead inside the furlong marker and was outfinished. WHOWHATHOW sprinted to a clear lead quickly, increased his margin through the second turn, then weakened late between rivals. FISH HOOKS well placed and inside, came through inside into the stretch and evened out. R PAINTED PAYNE allowed to settle, moved up slightly through the second turn on the two path, came three wide to bid and weakened the final furlong. VIRGING ON STARDOM improved his position. GREAT BEAR ran evenly. SECRET BIGS showed little. MIDNIGHT TUCKER well placed and inside, faded after three quarters. THE ONE THING was never involved.
