SURFING IAN broke well, contested the lead along the four path up the backstretch, took the three path on the turn, shook clear of GARGANTUA in the lane and was under the whip for the win. GARGANTUA was well placed along the rail, gained inside on the turn to challenge the winner, battled to no avail but finished well. PLEASE IMPRESS was well placed six wide up the backstretch, five wide on the turn, angled wide and finished with interest. PERSONAL SPENDER was unhurried along the two path, took the three path into the lane and then rallied wide. SHOW THE FLAG bumped by FEARLESS BUZZ at the five-eighths pole, checked, gained along the two path on the turn and then flattened out. FEARLESS BUZZ bumped with SHOW THE FLAG at the five-eighths pole, vied for the lead along the three path to the turn, angled to the four path and then tired. KOKOMO GYPSY lagged far back along the rail, was not a factor. EASY SPUR lagged back, five wide on the turn and then finished wide. LORD SIGMUNDO stumbled at the start, two path on the turn and tired. D' FIGHTER saved ground and then was done into the lane. MR. JOYSTICK well placed five wide up the backstretch and then was done four wide into the lane.
