LATE NIGHT HOOKUP broke on top, contested the lead from between foes up the backstretch, dueled with PAPA FRITA at the top of the lane, battled the latter and DAYS OF LIGHTNING a furlong out and under the whip held on for the win. PAPA FRITA forced the issue four across up the backstretch, dueled with the winner into the lane, battled outside of that one in midstretch and finished gamely while between on the wire. DAYS OF LIGHTNING vied for the lead along the rail, dropped back some into the lane, continued inside to the eighth pole, altered course to the outside and finished with good energy. BARCO was well placed along the rail, took the two path on the turn, lodged a bid and hung. CASTLE HARBOUR was unhurried along the rail, took the three path into the turn, two path on the bend, angled to the fence in the lane and then lacked a rally. FLAGLER BEACH was unhurried along the three path on the turn, angled out and then failed to gain. IS IT TUESDAY YET lagged back along the two path, was outrun. SECRETS ONLY vied for the lead from between three deep up the backstretch, dropped back into the lane and tired.
