SRIRACHA broke sluggishly, off the rail and pace, gained along the two path on the turn, angled out for room into the lane, launched a bid and rallied for the win. DISTINCTIVE LOVER was well placed saving ground, continued inside into the lane, responded to the whip and finished with good energy. OFFSHORE SCORE was unhurried along the four path up the backstretch, four path on the turn, angled wide in the lane and rallied. HAROLDS WARRIOR tracked along the three path up the backstretch, took the two path on the turn, grabbed the lead in midstretch but could not keep it going. BEACH ASSAULT was well placed along the four path, tracked on the three path around the corner, moved to challenge in midstretch but could not sustain the bid. MERCER CROSSING never far back along the four path after a half mile, three path on the turn and weakened. ENGINE FIVE broke slow, lagged back, three path on the turn, was outrun. GOTAGETHTEGREEN broke on top, set the pace along the rail, was hooked into the lane and gave way.
