Footnotes

TEN BELLS was well placed along the rail, gained inside on the last turn to challenge SCIBELLI and TRICKANOMETRY, took charge in the lane and under the whip proved best. TWO GENDARMES was unhurried off the rail up the backstretch, gained some along the two path on the last turn, continued inside making a move, chased and finished well. NEW YORK STYLE was well placed along the three path up the backstretch, gained along the three path on the last turn, four wide into the lane, lodged a bid outside and hung. TRICKANOMETRY volleyed for the lead with SCIBELLI up the backstretch, three across on the pace into the lane and weakened. TENSE lagged back along the rail early, took the three path up the backstretch, continued on that path on the last turn and then failed to fire. SCIBELLI vied for the lead off the rail, two path on the last turn, between foes into the lane and gave way. COUPON was unhurried along the four path up the backstretch, five wide into the lane and tired. KING KONG KINGDOMS saved ground while trailing up the backstretch and tired.
