BEDROCK BLUES broke slow, gained along the three path on the turn, reached contention in midstretch and under the whip edged clear. TRI CRUSADING lagged far back, four path on the turn and then rallied wide. JOHN DAIN vied for the lead along the three path, battled in the lane and weakened. CELTIC CAT was unhurried, three path on the turn, eased out and rallied. TOOP DE VILLE gained along the three path, challenged in the lane and weakened. JOHN 'N HOWARD saved ground, lodged a bid and hung. ONE DIAMOND broke sluggishly, saved ground and then lacked a rally. JARACAT vied for the lead along the two path, checked in midstretch and weakened. MAN OF THUNDER was well placed along the four path to the lane and tired.
