NEW YORK TOUGH broke alertly, quickly established command, set the pace while along the fence on the turn, was asked in the lane and under pressure gave JOCKEY SILVIA ZAPICO her first career tally. HERE COMES VINNY was unhurried off the rail up the backstretch, took the three path on the bend, angled out and finished well to earn the place. HOOKED ON DANCE stalked the winner along the rail up the backstretch, dropped back into the lane, responded and made a late bid from between horses. THREE O'CLOCK ROCK was well placed along the three path up the backstretch, two path on the turn, took the rail in the lane and finished well. EXLEY was well placed four off the rail up the backstretch, took the three path on the turn and weakened. DIXIELAND STAR was unhurried along the rail, continued inside on the turn, eased out and tired. HI HO SILVERMAN stumbled at the start, lagged back along the rail and then failed to respond.
