CITY GONE WILD well placed and between rivals, gained a striking position on the two path through the second turn, bid between rivals, drifting in to brushing MESSAGE OF LOVE into the stretch, then dueled with that one and edged ahead late. MESSAGE OF LOVE tracked the early pace, moved up and got through inside through the second turn, then was brushed by CITY GONE WILD into the stretch, dueled with that one and was outfinished. EL PATRON ESPECIAL well placed and outside, looped to a striking position five wide through the second turn, angled in slightly to bid three wide, then lacked the needed late kick. MARY ANN'S KITCHEN set the pace on the inside, stayed on when challenged through the turn and held a share. SPARKS WILL FLY passed a tiring rival. ONE PRETTY CAT stalked the early pace outside and faded after three quarters. LOUDER THAN SOUND lost contact with the field and was eased over the wire.
