PHOBIA vied for the lead from between three deep early, two deep into the lane, battled with the winner and just missed. WHO'S LIVIN BETTOR was never far back, three path on the turn, responded and finished with good energy. IT'S MAGICAL four path on the turn, angled out and closed well. I CAN'T DANCE vied for the lead along the rail early and weakened. KIERAN J. Y. vied for the lead from between early, saved ground on the turn and tired. RULE SEVENTY SIX three path on the turn and then failed to menace. ALEX THE BARBER four path on the turn and tired. ATHLEAGUE ROS two path on the turn and tired. SOCA TEMPO five wide on the turn, appeared in distress, pulled up and then was vanned off.
