NEW YORK MIRACLE was well placed along the rail up the backstretch, gained inside on the last turn and into the lane, quickly reached the front, was soon hooked by QUEEN BE ONTRACK and under the whip outran that one to the line. QUEEN BE ONTRACK lagged back along the rail, took the two path on the last turn, eased out while gaining on the winner, hooked up with that one and just miss. ROYAL BRIDGE was unhurried two off the rail up the backstretch, entered the lane four wide and finished wide while making a late bid. MIDAS PROSPECT lagged back, three path on the turns, angled in for the drive and was going well late. CATILLAC CUTIE bumped at the start, tracked along the two path up the backstretch, reached the leaders from between foes midway on the last turn, battled some and weakened. DESERT DOCTOR was well placed along the three path, challenged three across midway on the last turn and faded. LUCKY CRUISE stumbled at the start, bumped with CATILLAC CUTIE, four wide on the first turn, five wide on the last turn and tired. FIGHTING BACK sprinted to the lead, set the pace along the rail, was hooked midway on the final turn and gave way.
