CHERRY LADY was well placed, three path on the turn, lodged a bid outside and finished well. SCARED MONEY saved ground on the turn, eased out and was going well late. FRESH FOOTNOTES was well placed along the four path on the turn and weakened. SUNSET HEIGHTS three path on the turn and then failed to menace. MAGGIE'S MIRACLE vied for the lead along the rail to the lane and tired. NAVEDANO lagged back along the rail, was outrun.
