TELL ME FIRST broke well, tracked INGER MANAGEMENT up the backstretch, continued on that path around the bend, moved to take on the latter, gained the lead and under the whip proved best. RULING DECISION was well placed four wide up the backstretch, three path on the turn, asked in the lane, gained and finished well to earn the place. JILLUKE was unhurried two from the rail, continued on that path, angled out some for room in the stretch and rallied. INGER MANAGEMENT broke on top, set the pace along the rail, was hooked in midstretch by the winner and then weakened. FELINEFELON was well placed saving ground, continued inside into the lane and weakened. CAJUN JET was unhurried off the rail up the backstretch, took the three path on the bend and then failed to gain. BRYAN KICKS was well placed three from the rail between rivals up the backstretch, two off the rail on the turn and weakened. LEGISLATOR lagged far back, two path on the turn, was outrun. VOLOS broke in the air, four wide up the backstretch, continued along that route rounding the bend and tired.
