OLD SCHOOL allowed to settle, moved up inside through the second turn, angled out to bid three wide, drifted in while gaining, brushed a rival, then drew off late. IRUSAN broke a step slowly and was allowed to settle, moved up on the two path to challenge through the second turn, gained a clear lead in the stretch, then could not match strides with the winner late and held the place safe. JIM'S DESTINY passed tiring rivals. MR REESE sprinted to a clear lead quickly, then faded in the drive. NEVER NAKED stalked the pace outside and faded after three quarters. DAYDREAMIN BOY well placed and outside, was through after a half.
