GYPSY WARRIOR was unhurried along the rail, eased out to the four path up the backstretch, gained from between foes midway on the final turn, battled with JESSIE TOWTRUCK briefly with a furlong to go, put that one away and drew off under the whip for the win. JESSIE TOWTRUCK lagged back along the rail, angled out to the three path up the backstretch, gained along that path on the final bend, reached the lead, was soon hooked and then finished well to best the rest. GOOGLY was unhurried four wide up the backstretch, gained along that path on the final turn, responded some in the lane and hung. PRINCE DYLAN broke well, set the pace off the rail, dueled after a half mile, took charge some at the three-eighths pole, was collared and weakened. REY OF THE ROAD tracked along the rail, challenged briefly after a half mile and tired along the rail on the last turn. EXCESS BOOKS was well placed four from the rail up the backstretch, took the three path into the last turn, angled to the rail for the drive and tired. MORDEN three between early while close up, four wide on the last turn and tired.
