Footnotes

FU PEGS BABY stalked along the three path, gained on MEMORY MOTEL on the final turn, took command from that one in the lane and then widened some while under pressure. MEMORY MOTEL broke well, set the pace in hand off the rail, was hooked by the winner, could not match strides with that one but stayed on well to secure the place. BORN TO DAZZLE was well placed four from the rail up the backstretch, continued wide on the last turn and then finished with interest. WATCHIN THE BABES checked at the start, lagged back two from the rail, angled to the three path on the last turn and then made a late bid. PLUS A FEVER was unhurried, saved ground up the backstretch, continued inside on the last turn and then made a mild bid. RELATIVELY READY rated along the rail, asked while four wide on the last turn and tired while well out in the lane. ZIPPY'S TIGER was well placed two from the rail around the track and tired.
