JEN'S LITE saved ground on the first turn, four path up the backstretch in hand, gained on the last turn, collared the leader in the lane, battled in a hand ride and then was under wraps for the win. STORMY EXPRESSION vied for the lead early, dropped back some, tracked along the three path, dueled, took command into the lane, was hooked, battled inside and finished gamely. GREEN DANCER ROAD bumped at the start by DANCE WITH LANCE, checked, lagged back along the rail, angled out in the lane while gaining and then flattened out. OVER DEE FENCE lagged back, gained on the final bend and then flattened out. DANCE WITH LANCE bumped with GREEN DANCER ROAD at the start and then was five wide on the last turn. FABULOUS GIN three abreast early on the pace, shook loose after a half mile, hooked and tired. KINGBORO'S SWORD saved ground while well placed to the lane and tired. FOREVER POUR vied for the lead briefly and gave way.
