BOBB'S RIZZI broke on top, vied for the lead along the three path from between foes, shook loose into the lane and then was kept to the whip for the win. SUAVE TODD vied for the lead along the four path while three abreast, chased in the lane to no avail but finished clearly second best. LIVELY EXIT was never far back along the rail, eased out in the lane, lodged a bid but was no match for the top two finishers. SHEZA WHIPPER forced the issued along the rail, battled into the lane, ducked in under right handed pressure, hit the rail at the three-sixteenth pole and weakened. DAN'S JET broke sluggishly, lagged back along the rail and then passed faders. TALE OF APPROVAL three path on the turn, angled out in the lane and then lacked a response. MILLIBROOK was well placed along the three path early, angled out in the lane and tired. OH DOMINO five wide on the turn, continued wide in the lane and tired. JOKERS WILD CARD four path, was not a factor. WHIPPERS DREAM broke awkwardly and then was outrun.
