BLAZING MISS FUFU four abreast on the pace early, stalked along the four path on the turn, took command nearing the eighth pole and under the whip held sway for the win. BAY DRAGON was unhurried along the rail, gained on the turn, angled out some in the lane, rallied, altered course to the inside and finished with good energy. DIXIE BABIE reared at the start, saved ground early, three path on the bend, angled out and finished well. CHAMPAGNEFORSHELBY lagged far back, angled wide in the lane and then found his best stride late. WATRAL SWEE DIXIE was never far back, four path on the bend and then lacked a closing bid. REGAL MIRACLE five wide on the turn and then lacked the late needed response. SHEILAS DESIRE vied for the lead along the three path while between foes, shook loose on the turn and then gave way. BUNNY SLOPE vied for the lead off the rail, tracked on the turn and gave way.
