Footnotes

DIXIELAND STAR contested the lead along the three path with DEVONSHIRE, put that one away into the lane and then widened under the whip proving clearly the best. MANDATE was unhurried five wide up the backstretch, took the four path on the turn, responded and rallied. HE AINT EASY was unhurried off the rail up the backstretch, eased out in the lane when able and rallied. DEVONSHIRE vied for the lead off the rail with the winner, saved ground to the inside of the latter on the bend, could not keep up and tired. IS IT TUESDAY YET was unhurried three from the rail up the backstretch, angled wide in the lane and then failed to gain. BARCO was well placed four wide up the backstretch, three path into the lane in striking distance and tired. CASTLE HARBOUR saved ground while well placed up the backstretch and then tired along the rail into the lane.
