QUITE EXCLUSIVE contested the lead off the rail, responded into the lane, took command with a furlong to go and under the whip proved best. PRISCILLA'S CHANCE was unhurried along the four path, gained ground on the turn, lost the whip nearing the quarter pole, entered the lane six wide and then closed well in a hand ride to clearly best the rest. BIOGIO'S SPIRIT dueled for the lead along the rail, battled into the lane, chased and then weakened. PARTY FINALE was well placed along the four path on the turn and then weakened. BEBOP BLUES was not a threat. ANGEL'S WAGER lagged back along the rail, gained ground on the turn, angled out into the lane and then flattened out. GOLDEN JACKIE four path on the turn and weakened.
