BIG OUT was well placed, angled out five wide into the lane, quickly took command, opened up some and under the whip proved best. TOMORROW THE WORLD broke sluggishly, gained along the four path on the turn, lodged a bid from between and finished well. GALLANT SOLDIER off the rail, angled out in the lane, lacked room in midstretch, angled wide for room and finished with good energy. DIAMOND ROCK five wide on the turn, angled wide in the lane and finished with interest. WHO'S LIVIN BETTOR vied for the lead along the rail early and weakened. TOUGH AND EASY broke sluggishly and then could not keep up. FLY BY MOONLIGHT gained six wide on the turn and weakened. GEM'S HONOR vied for the lead from between foes, dueled into the lane and tired. MASTER TEACHER vied for the lead three across early, dueled on the turn and gave way. SILVER PROSPECTOR broke sluggishly and then was outrun.
