SOUNDS FREUDIAN jostled at the start, lagged back, four wide on the turn, lacked room in upper stretch, checked, angled out for room and rallied for the win. SMARTY AYA was well placed along the rail, chased in the lane, gained and finished gamely to just miss. DENISE'S MISS EL was well placed tracking along the three path on the turn, lodged a bid and finished with interest. SPRING BREEZE sprinted clear, set the pace off the rail, was hooked and weakened. MONEY CHARGER tracked along the three path up the backstretch, two path on the turn, gained some and hung. PURE LOVE four path up the backstretch, four wide on the turn in striking distance into the lane and weakened. PRIVATE SCREENING was unhurried, four path leaving the backstretch, bore out some into the lane and then finished wide. LOST BADGE away last, appeared in distress, pulled up and then was vanned off.
