SHESASTONECOLDFOX broke alertly, set the pace removed from the rail, widened and then was ridden out to the line proving clearly best. PRINCESS DIXIE tracked the leader along the four path, lodged a bid in the lane but was clearly no match for the winner. ALLTAPPEDOUT saved ground, eased out some in the lane but was no match for the top two finishers. TAP THE GOLD checked after the start while between foes, saved ground, lacked a rally. RINGALING lagged back along the three path, could not keep up. JOLTEON chased early, three path on the turn and then steadily dropped out of it.
