WILD CHILLY tracked the winner along the three path and weakened. MAIN MAN SANDY was unhurried six wide and then lacked a rally. MY BROTHER JOHN was unhurried off the rail and weakened. LOST SWORD broke slow, was outrun. WIT SPEED TO BURN bolted on the turn and then finished wide.
