ALCANUDANCE contested the lead from between up the backstretch, continued between on the bend, battled inside to the line and under the whip proved best. NEW YORK TOUGH vied for the lead three across up the backstretch, continued that way on the turn, battled in the lane from between foes leaving the eighth pole and then just missed. BARCO never far back, two path up the backstretch, three path into the lane, lodged a bid and hung. BRAVE YANK was well placed four from the rail up the backstretch, appeared in striking distance into the lane and then failed to gain. DAYS OF LIGHTNING vied for the lead along the rail to the lane and gave way. LISCANNOR BAY unhurried along the rail, angled out in the lane and then failed to respond.
