Footnotes

JITALIAN in hand along the three path well placed up the backstretch, gained when asked into the lane, moved to challenge from between foes in midstretch and under the whip held sway. PRINCE CODY was unhurried three from the rail up the backstretch, gained along the two path on the last turn, continued inside into the lane and finished gamely. RAECINJASIN was unhurried four wide on the first turn, continued four wide on the last turn, gained some on the outside and hung in the crucial stages. HOT ACT was unhurried four from the rail up the backstretch, took the two path on the last turn and then failed to threaten. READING GROUP tracked the leader, challenged after a half mile, put that one away leaving the five-sixteenths pole, took charge into the lane and then had nothing left for the final eighth. ETRUSCAN PROPHET lagged back along the rail, angled out into the lane and then showed very little. BLUE SANDS was well placed along the rail up the backstretch and tired. SEEK TO DESTROY set the pace in hand, was hooked, matched strides to the final turn, lost the lead midway on the last turn and then steadily gave it up.
