WILLIAM THOMAS broke in the air, well placed four off the rail up the backstretch, gained three from the rail on the turn, collared the leader nearing the eighth pole, battled some and then drove clear. CAYO HUESO broke on top, dueled along the three path up the backstretch with FELINEFELON, put that rival away along the two path around the corner, was soon collared by the winner, battled some to no avail but finished well to best the rest. PAPA FRITA never far back three off the rail up the backstretch, continued that way on the turn, responded late and finished with interest. FELINEFELON contested the lead off the rail early, saved ground on the turn and weakened. DUCALE unhurried along the rail, took the three path around the bend and then failed to respond. CASTLE HARBOUR was unhurried off the rail on the turn and then steadily dropped back in the lane.
