### Footnotes

DOUBLE PRIME was well placed in hand along the two path up the backstretch, began to gain three from the rail on the last turn, hooked up with UPSET ALERT in upper stretch, matched strides with that one and under the whip proved best. UPSET ALERT tracked the leader along the three path up the backstretch, collared that one into the last turn, cleared at the top of the lane, was soon hooked by the winner and then failed to stay on but did best the rest. NIKKI'S EYES broke well, set the pace along the rail, was hooked nearing the final turn, chased inside and tired. DAVID'S FLAME was unhurried two from the rail up the backstretch, saved ground on the final bend and tired. LITTLE RITA lagged back saved ground, continued inside to the line and tired. HAVANA GIRL was unhurried three from the rail up the backstretch, continued on that path around the bend and tired. VIV'S TIARA fractious in the gate, four path up the back stretch well placed and then took the two path on the final bend while tiring.
