PATRIARCH POPS broke well, set the pace along the four path, was hooked, battled and finished gamely to just miss. WHIZBANG tracked the leader up the backstretch, four path on the last turn and weakened. MY BIG TREASURE lagged back, four path on the last turn and then failed to take part. CASH ME OUT was well placed up the backstretch along the three path and tired. TORTILLA SOUP showed little. TO THE REPUBLIC showed nothing. FIVE STAR GOLD five wide on the last turn and tired.
