MISS RUMPUS stalked along the rail, continued inside on the final turn, challenged at the top of the lane, battled along the rail in the lane and under the whip got the nod. KITTY KAT ROCKSTAR broke well, set the pace off the rail, was hooked at the top of the lane, battled outside and finished gamely to just miss. ST. PETE BEACH was well placed five wide up the backstretch, gained along the three path on the last turn and flattened out. MIRTHFUL FLIRT was unhurried three from the rail, four wide on the last turn, angled out and hung. EMERALD CITY GIRL stalked the leader along the three path, dropped back along the three path on the last turn and weakened. MOON DROP broke sluggishly, unhurried two from the rail, continued on that path on the last turn, angled out and then failed to gain. ALEJA GRAND ducked out at the start, saved ground well placed to the last turn and tired. CATHY ALL THE WAY saved ground and trailed without mishap.
