HIGH STAKES POKER quickly assumed command, set the pace along the three path and then widened in the lane while kept to the whip. MARK THE TRICK was unhurried six wide on the turn, angled out in the lane and finished with good energy. HURRY UP HILLARD was well placed along the four path on the bend, lodged a bid and finished with interest. SKIM THE RAIL stalked the winner off the rail and weakened. DAVID IS MAD five wide between foes and then continued wide in the lane. FIRST EXPRESSION three path nearest the rail and weakened. NORMAN'S GOOD BOY fractious in the gate, broke sluggishly, lagged back and then angled wide in the lane.
