BRUNO'S BURST was well placed along the three path into the lane, angled out some, gained and under the whip got the job done. LION ON THE RUN broke well, vied for the lead, shook loose on the turn, was hooked and then finished well to best the rest. TOOP DE VILLE was unhurried saving ground, responded, eased out some and made a late bid. LITTLE DANIEL was well placed along the rail, tracked the leader into the lane and finished with interest. SNEAKY GUY was unhurried along the two path and made a mild bid. ALL WEST four path on the turn, lodged a bid and hung. RAYNICK'S TOKEN tracked along the three path and tired. CAMPANA three path on the turn and then failed to take part. HEAP O' TROUBLE four path on the turn and tired.
