FRENCH HIDEAWAY was unhurried while five wide up the backstretch, gained ground along the four path on the final bend, launched a bid into the lane, reached contention with a furlong to go, collared the leader and then under the whip proved best. S'MORE SMOKE five wide up the backstretch, gained, tracked leaving the backstretch along the four path, moved to challenge midway on the final turn, took command in the lane, was hooked and then finished well to best the rest. MARKET GURU was unhurried along the four path, gained ground on the last turn, lodged a bid in the drive and then flattened out. SICILIAN PRINCESS broke sluggishly, lagged back, four path on the last turn and then made a late gain. PERTY NUMBER was never far back along the three path, gained some on the last turn, lodged a bid outside and weakened. SILENT ANNIE was unhurried off the rail and then failed to menace. STORM ON THE LAKE vied for the lead along the three path, dueled on the last turn and tired. OUR TUNE vied for the lead off the rail for a half mile, dropped back and then was eased in the stretch.
