PATRON SAINT gained five wide up the backstretch, continued on along the three path around to the turn, challenge for the lead three across at the top of the lane, battled with SWING AT SIRO'S and under the whip put that one away and drove clear. SWINGING AT SIRO'S contested the lead three across early, battled between into the lane, matched strides with the winner nearing the eighth pole and then could not keep pace but finished second best. ANOTHER SILVER OAK was well placed four from the rail, two path on the turn, eased out some and finished with interest. READY VICTORY contested the lead off the rail up the backstretch, hugged the rail on the turn and faded. BARCO two path up the backstretch, three from the rail around the bend, asked and then failed to gain. THE ZIPSTER was unhurried four from the rail leaving the backstretch, entered the straight five wide and then failed to fire. FLAGLER BEACH lagged back, three off the rail on the turn and then failed to take part. SURFING IAN saved ground close up early, continued inside on the turn and tired.
