LIFE OF THE CITY was well placed in hand, lacked room at the three-eighths pole, checked, angled out four wide into the lane, gained, challenged SECOND AND ONE with a furlong to go, battled and under the whip proved best. SECOND AND ONE was well placed tracking four wide on the turn, found the front nearing the eighth pole, was hooked, battled and just missed. MY BOY FRANK vied for the lead off the rail early, took command along the two path on the turn, was hooked and faded. SUN DAGGER jostled at the start, well placed along the rail around the turn and weakened. EUROSENSATION was unhurried along the rail, two path on the turn and then failed to respond. CHIEF RUCKUS jostled at the start, lagged back along the two path and then failed to threaten. MIDASIDO broke slow, angled out four wide around the bend, was outrun. PSYCH MAJOR vied for the lead three off the rail up the backstretch, tracked on that path on the turn and tired.
