MARSH DAWG set the pace well off the rail, angled in into the turn and shook clear into the stretch, then drew off in the lane and was kept to the task. STARSHIP CAPTAIN stalked the pace on the outside, moved up to challenge through the turn, could not match strides with the winner into the stretch, stayed on and held the place safe. SAY MR. SANDMAN tracked the pace on the outside, moved through the turn three wide, came four wide to bid and get up for the show, while no threat to the top two. THATSATRUESTORY tracked the pace on the inside, dropped back through the turn, then improved his position in the lane. HAYA'S BOY well placed and between rivals, had no rally. ROCK STAR CHARLIE was never involved.
