THEKEYTOLAUGHTER tracked the leader along the three path, took command leaving the backstretch and then widened to be a ridden out winner. IFEELMISTY lagged back along the three path, angled to the rail on the last turn, launched a bid inside in the lane and finished clearly best of the rest. BORN TO BOP was well placed while five wide up the backstretch, chased into the lane and then flattened out. HI MOUNTS DIAMOND was well placed, saved ground on the last turn, angled out in the lane and weakened. SLICE'S COLOR lagged back along the rail and then lacked a rally. REMEMBER BRIAN broke slow, lagged back and then was five wide on the last turn. ZACHS WORLD set the pace off the rail, was hooked after a half mile, duelled briefly, chased into the lane and then tired. QUARRY CONTENDER six wide trip, tired.
