ORA was never far back along the four path, between foes midway on the turn, angled out in the lane, responded to the whip and rallied for the win. RUNAWAY TIGER vied for the lead along the five path up the backstretch, angled to the three path leaving the three-eighth pole, took command into the lane, opened up some and then could not handle the winner and had to settle for second best. CAMIONETTE was unhurried off the rail on the turn, angled out some into the lane, launched a bid and finished well. DOUBLE THE DEBT broke sluggishly, well placed along the three path, between foes on the turn, chased in the lane and weakened. MISS ROYAL IBIS lagged back along the rail, angled out wide in the lane and then made a mild gain. CLIFDEN STAR lagged back and then swung out extremely wide in the lane. DIABLOSANGELEYES was well placed while five wide on the turn and weakened. TWINKLE TWINKLE vied for the lead along the four path up the backstretch, off the rail on the turn and then tired.
