CAT'S PLAYMATE never far back, gained along the two path on the last turn, took a quick lead and then was ridden out. HEAR HER ROAR was unhurried, four path on the turns, gained into the lane and rallied. NOW NOW GIRL was well placed, challenged at the top of the lane to no avail, chased and finished with interest. INDIA DOLL taken back at the start, lagged far back, saved ground, angled wide and made a late bid. PLATINUM ADVANTAGE was unhurried, two path on the turns and then made a mild bid. SPECTACULARSPINDLS saved ground on the last turn and then lacked a rally. MONTESSORI never far back, gained along the four path on the last turn and flattened out. HELYNA'S DREAMING was well placed along the three path on the turns and tired. HOLD THE CRUISER vied for the lead, saved ground on the turns and gave way. PENNYANNIE COWGIRL vied for the lead along the two path on the turns and gave way.
