Footnotes

LINEAR MOTION forced the issue early, tracked two off the rail on the turn, responded, gained and under the whip got the money. LE FREAK was unhurried three from the rail up the backstretch, continued outside into the lane and rallied. ITS GOODTOBEKING broke well, set the pace while pressed early, took charge along the rail around the bend, was hooked late and weakened. TRACK MAGNET was unhurried off the rail, hugged the rail on the turn, lodged a bid inside and hung. EMPTY WALLET was well placed three from the rail, continued on that path around the corner, lodged a bid outside and weakened. BOB THE POOL MAN saved ground unhurried along the rail, two path on the turn and tired.
