### Footnotes

MISS IVY HILTON tracked the leader along the three path, gained the lead into the lane, drifted into the path of CAMIONETTE in upper stretch, battled for the lead with a furlong to go and then drove clear. ROCAJUL lagged back along the three path, angled out on the last turn, checked into the lane, responded when asked and rallied. CAM A RETTA was well placed along the four path, gained ground on the last turn, moved to challenge for the lead into the lane, battled and then weakened late. LADY BUTTON EYES was unhurried along the four path, angled out in the lane and then lacked a solid bid. WATRALS TWELVBELW set the pace off the rail, was hooked on the last turn, battled and then faded. TACTICAL LADY lagged back, bolted on the last turn and then was pulled up. CAMIONETTE was well placed along the rail, gained ground on the last turn, lodged a bid into the lane, clipped heels with MISS IVY HILTON when she drifted in, stumbled and then unseated the jockey. LAISEA saved ground, stumbled over the fallen jockey into the lane and unseated the jockey. A stewards inquiry was posted concerning the incident at the quarter pole, resulted in the disqualification of MISS IVY HILTON from first to last.
