Footnotes

KING'S LASSIE was never far back along the rail, lodged a bid inside to collar the leader, put that one away and drove clear. ANDREA STAR lagged back along the rail, eased out for the drive and finished well to earn the place. FLEETENGLY bumped hard at the start by GOLDEN JACKIE, lagged back, gained ground while five wide on the last turn and rallied. SUNSHINE RONDEVOU broke on top, set the pace along the three path, was hooked in midstretch and tired. CAT WOMAN was well placed off the rail, eased out in the lane and weakened. GOLDEN JACKIE ducked in bumping hard with FLEETINGLY at the start and then lagged back while saving ground. WILLOW BEND tracked the leader along the four path to the lane weakened. MISS JULIAN was well placed while five wide up the backstretch and tired. COAL INMY STOCKING was well placed along the four path for a half mile and tired.
