OLD SCHOOL never far back, three path on the last turn, responded, rallied to collar the leader a sixteenths out and then drifted out to the wire while clear. ANDROPHY broke well, dueled along the rail, cleared in upper stretch and then finished gamely. FINAL STRIDE was unhurried five wide up the backstretch, four wide on the last turn and then made a late bid from the well out in the strip. CAMERON CANYON was well placed off the rail up the backstretch, hugged the fence on the last turn, bothered by MAKE A DREAM at the sixteenths pole, checked and weakened. TED LEFT EARLY was well placed four wide up the backstretch, three path on the last turn, between in midstretch, was forced out BY MAKE A DREAM at the sixteenths pole, checked and weakened. MAKE A DREAM vied for the lead along the three path up the backstretch, two path on the last turn, drifted out nearing the sixteenths pole bothering rivals and weakened. EPIC LEGEND was unhurried along the rail and tired. BALTIC COAST lagged back five wide into the backstretch, saved ground on the last turn and tired. A Stewards inquiry was posted concerning the stretch run, resulted in no change.
