**Footnotes**

FRISKY WARRIOR angled out bothering HOT ACT at the seven-sixteenths pole, took the three path into the lane, asked, gained and bested SUNDAE ON SUNDAY for the win. SUNDAE ON SUNDAY was well placed along the rail, slipped inside into the lane, took command and then finished gamely to just miss. METAURUS in hand early, gained along the three path when asked, chased and weakened. EVERYBODY'S DADDY was well placed, appeared to be in tight quarters nearing the three-eighths pole, checked out, took the rail into the lane and tired. READY VICTORY broke well, set the pace off the rail and gave way. HOT ACT well placed up the backstretch, was bothered by the winner at the three-eighths pole, checked, angled out in the lane and tired. A claim of foul was lodged by the rider of HOT ACT against the winner for interference at the seven-sixteenths pole, was not allowed.
