LEMON PEEL was unhurried along the three path up the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, eased out in the lane, responded, rallied to take the lead in gear and drew off. AMERICAN SKY lagged back along the rail, angled out three wide into the lane, asked and rallied to best the rest. FOOTNOTE IN BLUE vied for the lead along the rail, kicked loose some in midstretch and then gave way. U OUGHT TO KNOW broke well, contested the lead along the two path, chased in midstretch and weakened. TIMOTHY'S BOY was unhurried three from the rail, two path on the turn, entered the lane inside and tired. REAL WONDER broke sluggishly, four wide up the backstretch, three path around the turn and tired.
