**Footnotes**

TRUFFULA was unhurried off the rail, gained along the two path on the last turn, eased out some, asked, rallied and drew off. AMPLY REWARDED was unhurried four wide on the first turn, continued four wide on the last turn, angled out and finished with good energy. IMALADY STELLA was unhurried along the rail, continued inside on the last turn, lodged a bid inside and finished with interest. VICTORIOUS DEVIL broke well, vied for the lead along the rail, shook loose after a half mile, opened some and then weakened. DOUBLE PRIME was well placed four path up the backstretch, four path on the last turn angled out and weakened. GREAT PRESS vied for the lead along the three path and tired.
