PERRY LANE was unhurried, three path on the turn, gained inside, angled out late and under the whip proved best. SOLUTIONIST ducked out slamming QUINTESSENTIAL at the start, vied for the lead off the rail, took charge on the turn and then finished well but could not handle the winner. WILD CHILLY was well placed, four path on the turn, chased and finished with interest. KING'S FEZ gained along the four path into the lane, lodged a bid and hung. BEHRACUDA was unhurried, four path on the turn and then lacked a solid bid. DONTSTEALMYLAND ducked in slamming QUINTESSENTIAL at the start, checked, five wide on the turn and then failed to take part. TOUGH COOKIE T vied for the lead early, tracked along the four path and tired. QUINTESSENTIAL slammed from both sides at the start, saved ground and tired. KEY STRATEGY was well placed early, saved ground on the turn and tired.
