PEGASUS ENA tracked along the two path on the turns, gained, challenged in midstretch, responded when roused and drew clear to be ridden out. SIR GUSTA set the pace along the rail, was hooked a furlong out, battled to no avail but finished well. DIAMOND DISTRICT saved ground on the final turn while in striking distance and hung. FIFTY SENSE was unhurried, gained along the three path on the last turn and flattened out. COME ON OVER was unhurried, two path on the final turn and then failed to fire. RONNIES FOOTNOTES broke slow, hurried to reach contention, well placed along the three path on the turns and weakened. WINNERS LAUGH saved ground and tired.
