### Footnotes

GOOD LAW was unhurried up the backstretch, angled out to the four path on the last turn, gained, collared the leaders while three across in midstretch and under the whip drew off. YOUR HOUR'S UP was never far back off the rail, angled wide in the lane and rallied. YOU SURE was well placed along the four path up the backstretch, three path on the last turn and then finished well. FIFTY SENSE tracked the leader along the three path to midstretch and weakened. REDAN set the pace off the rail to midstretch and faded. XTREME SPEED tracked off the rail to the last turn and tired. CAPTAIN PETE saved ground, was outrun.
